- 2. Dave reported that Emily is being paid through the Battle Creek Community Foundation and it sometimes takes up to 60 days for the foundation to process a payment. KGMS has been paying the foundation for Emily's services and the foundation keeps a portion of that payment. Also, Emily has been buying the supplies for kids club on her own. There was a motion made to advise Emily to provide an invoice to KGMS for her Kids Club services and KGMS pay her directly and increase her pay to \$195 - \$200 per month. It would be Emily's responsibility to make sure the Foundation receives their portion of the payment. Emily would provide receipts for Kids Club supplies directly to KGMS for reimbursement. Motion was seconded and passed pending discussion and approval from the Battle Creek Community Foundation.

Dave to discuss possibilities with Emily and get approval from the foundation for KGMS to pay Emily directly and have Emily send a portion of payment to the foundation. Dave to request approval be on Foundation letterhead for auditing and liability purposes

- 3. Dave obtained Fluorite cubes from vendor at Tailgate to be used for Kids Club
- 4. There were 6-8 kids at the September meeting
- 5. Dave is still working on finding a Point of Contact at Olivet for possible scholarship opportunity
- Dave discussed scholarship options with Point of Contact at Kalamazoo Valley Community College. Scholarship winners would receive a free one-year membership to KGMS, but would also be required to work more hours at the show. Attendance to meetings would also be encouraged.
